The York County Area Agency on Aging (YCAAA) will host a listening session on the development of the Master Plan for Older Adults – a 10year, state-led and stakeholder-driven strategic plan designed to help transform the infrastructure and coordination of services for older Pennsylvanians. The master plan will also reflect the needs and preferences of older adults to live where they choose and access the supports they need to thrive and age in place.
