<u>Trash</u>: Trash should **NOT** be placed curbside before 6PM the day before pick-up, which is on Monday, or the day prior to a holiday pick-up schedule. Please be sure trash can lids are secure and bags are securely tied.

<u>Parking Restrictions on Borough Streets</u> - Please abide by the one-hour parking restrictions that are posted in the Borough. Parking restrictions are in effect Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM. Saturday, Sunday and holidays are excluded. Violators can be ticketed.

#### Leona's Cafe at 56 S Main St, Dover.

Named to honor the owner's grandmother, Leona's offers family recipes. In addition to menu staples, such as cheddar ale soup, chicken salad, cobb salads, scones, meatballs, pretzel bombs, and gourmet cupcakes, specials will be available. Periodically, you will find international dishes, beginning with the Taste of Ireland for their March opening. Keto options are planned as well. The Zen Den is a cozy seating area perfect for enjoying coffee or tea and a pastry. Some gourmet products, such as maple syrup and balsamic vinegars used in their menu items, will be for sale as well. Leona's will be open daily from 7AM thru 7Pm. Parking is available on the side and back of the building.

**ATV's and Motor Bikes:** Riding ATVs, dirt bikes, minibikes, and mopeds is **NOT** permitted in the Borough.

<u>Fire Pits:</u> Recreational fire pits may not exceed 3ft. by 3 Ft. or 3 Ft. diameter. Permanent structures require a building permit and must be 25 ft from any building; enclosed portable fire pits must be 15 ft from any building. Fires are not permitted in wind speed greater than 15 mph, or when Dover Borough has enacted a ban on outdoor burning; must always be supervised by a responsible adult 18 yrs. or older; and water or a fire extinguisher must be immediately accessible. Only natural wood, charcoal and fuel "logs" may be used. If a burning appliance (chiminea, patio warmer, etc.) is not used, all ground fires, must be surrounded by stone, metal, or concrete ring.

<u>Grass/Weeds and Overhanging trees:</u> Property owners/occupants are responsible to maintain lawns and remove grasses or weeds from the sidewalk and curb adjacent to the property, including weeds at street level at the curb. Grass clippings should not be blown into the streets because they can clog storm drains. Trees, bushes, and other vegetation may not protrude over or overhang sidewalks. A minimum ten-foot vertical clearance from the sidewalk is required.
