TIPS
for proper disposal
of Hot Ashes

- 01.** Allow ashes to cool in the area where you had the fire for several days.
- 02.** Test to ensure the ashes are cool by placing them in a cardboard box or paper bag before disposal.
- 03.** Transfer the cool ash to a plastic bag and tie it shut to ensure no dust gets out then place with your trash.
- 04.** Never dispose of hot ashes with yard waste.
